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Herewith is a record of all I could find out about my ancestor, Selah Woodworth, a Revolutionary Soldier. It is also as nearly as possible a complete record of his descendants nearly 1000 in number. His line of descent from Walter Woodworth is also given.

For convenience and as a means of identification each descendant has been given a number, Selah Woodworth himself being No. 1. Children have been numbered consecutively in order of birth and appear in numerical order throughout the record. Since in each life sketch parents names always appear with their proper number in brackets it is possible to trace lines of descent forward or backward from generation to generation. An asterisk (\*) placed before the name of a child indicates that more information will be found about him and his descendants in its proper numerical order on some later page of the record. All names have been indexed.

## LIFE SKETCH OF SELAH WOODWORTH

During the Revolution and the period immediately thereafter was a time in this country when men's character was tested and when leadership was developed. Now and then some man stood head and shoulders above his fellows. Such a man was Selah Woodworth. Very little has been written about this pioneer and soldier who helped found a town in the wilderness, wrest it from the British, protect it from the Indians, and become it's first civic leader and a sponsor of it's religious activity. Until recently even Selah's record as a Revolutionary Soldier has been overlooked. Perhaps this has been because his military services were eclipsed by those of his brothers Captain Gershom Woodworth and Captain Soloman Woodworth whose exploits are well known. Selah Woodworth was only a sergeant but every military man knows that to be a sergeant requires true leadership.

Much about Selah Woodworth's ancestors may be found in an old Woodworth Genealogy published in 1898. That record is now being revised by the Woodworth family. The Coat-of-arms belonging to this branch of the family may be found in Vol. V "First Families of America". The first mentioned Woodworth in history is said to have been the Commissary of William The Conqueror and is depicted in a scene on the famous Bayeau Tapestry entitled "Hic est Wadard".

Selah Woodworth the first of the line to bear that name was the son of Caleb Woodworth and Jane daughter of Samuel Munger. He was the grandson of Benjamin Woodworth of Lebanon, Conn. Benjamin's father Walter Woodworth was the immigrant ancestor and came to America in 1630 on the "Mary and John". Walter settled in the town of Scituate, Mass. Samuel Woodworth who wrote the "Old Oaken Bucket" was Selah's second cousin twice removed. Selah Woodworth was born in Salisbury, Conn. on Aug. 11 1750 and was the youngest of eleven children whose names in order of birth were, Gershom, Jane, Ephraim, William, Cyrenus, Freelove, Amos, Sarah, Deliverance, and Soloman.

On December 20th 1773 Selah Woodworth was married to Rebecca Dunham daughter of Jacob Dunham then of Sheffield. They were married in Salisbury. The Dunham ancestry may be found in the Dunham Genealogy. Jacob was the son of Daniel who was the son of Rev. Jonathan Dunham, who was the son of Deacon John Dunham. A complete chart of Selah's and Rebecca's American ancestry may be found on page 41 of a record by the writer published 1934 entitled "Ancestors and Descendants of Robert Brown".

Shortly after their marriage Selah Woodworth and his wife bought land and settled in the Town of Mayfield, now in Fulton County N.Y. He is mentioned with seventeen others as heads of families to whom Sir William Johnson and Dan Claus sold land in the vicinity of Mayfield. Simm's "Trappers of New York" page 49 reads: "A settlement was begun in Mayfield some ten miles north of Johnston Hall under the patronage of Sir William Johnson. The first settlers who obtained land from the Baronet were, Soloman and Seeley Woodworth, Simeon Christie, Jacob Dunham, and Canfield. Christie was a Scotchman, the others enterprising Yankees from Salisbury, Conn.

The last paragraph is slightly misleading. It is probable that Selah did have the good sense to remove his wife and children to the safety of Conn. during the Indian and Tory massacres that took place in that part of the country during the Revolution, but Selah himself braved the dangers and like many of his brothers fought for American Independence.

The exploits of Selah's brother Soloman are well known but little is known of Selah's actions but he is listed as a sargeant of Tryon Co. militia in "New York in the Revolution". He was a member of Captain Little's company in the Third regiment under Col. Fischer. This regiment took part in the Battle of Oriskany. In Simm's "Frontiersmen of New York" vol. 2 pg. 235 is a description of the massacre by Indians of Jacob Dunham and family. Jacob was the father of Selah Woodworth's wife. The book also tells how Selah's brother Soloman avenged this murder and killed the Indians involved. The same book states that Soloman's brother "Seeley" as he was called "was several times engaged in military service". In recognition of this the D.A.R. has placed a marker on Selah's grave in Mayfield, N.Y.

After the war Selah brought his family back to Mayfield, but he may have lived for a time in White Creek, Washington, Co. N.Y. as one record states that his daughter Sarah was born there in the year 1779. One of the founders of Mayfield, N.Y. Selah became very prominent in local affairs being elected the first supervisor of the town in 1794 and holding that position almost continuously until 1805. He is mentioned frequently in the old town records where the caemarks by which he identified his cattle is described as "A squair crop off the left ear and a half-penny on the fore side of the same". An interesting affidavit made by him in 1821 when he was Overseer of the Poor reads: "We the subscribers do certify that it appears to us that Dine a female slave belonging to Abram Wells of the Town of Mayfield is under 21 years of age and of sufficient ability to provide for herself and we do hereby provide that the town clerk of the town of Mayfield make an entry of record of the same. Given under our hand and seal this 12th day of May 1821". Signed Selah Woodworth, William G Woodworth, Overseers of the Poor.

The land purchased by Selah Woodworth is said to include most of the land where the village of Mayfield now stands. His home was about a mile directly west of the center of the village on what was then the main road. The house built by him still stands. The farm is known as the Woodworth Place and has always been occupied by a member of the Woodworth family.

Selah has been mentioned as one of the founders of the M.E. Church at Mayfield. He and his wife decded the land in the village where the present church now stands. The deed was dated Jan. 28 1823 and was made out to Paris G Clark, William McConnell, Samuel Woodworth, John Cozzens and Jacob Woodworth. The commissioner of deeds did not certify to the signatures until Nov. 19 1824 more than a year after Selah's death and the deed was not recorded until 1882.

Selah Woodworth died Oct. 25 1823 at the age of 73. The inscription on the headstine appears to read 1825 but this is in error since his will was probated Dec. 15 1823. The 1823 date is also given on an old engraved family record apparently taken or copied from the family Bible. This record also gives the dates of the births and deaths of all Selah's children.

Selah Woodworth's funeral was held in the new church before it was completed. Rev. Wm. Krieger in writing about Mayfield history described the funeral as follows: "It had been noised abroad that Selah Woodworth was dead. A subdued, reverent throng had gathered about the church. They had come on foot, on horseback from Dentons Corners and Pleasant Square, from Munsonville and Jackson Summit, from Red Bunch and Benedicts Corners, from Fondas Bush and Kingsboro. As they waited they talked in subdued tones about the unpainted church and about the Dedication service set for early in December. But mostly they talked about Brother Woodworth who scarcely nine months before had deeded the lot to the trustees of the newly incorporated church. Some of the men were old like him who they had gathered to honor. They shuddered now as they told of experiences with the Indians and encounters with the Tories."

Rev. Kreiger in his descriptions of conversarions overheard relates various historical incidents involving members of the Woodworth family. William Cozzens is quoted as follows: "Even Brother Woodworth lost a baby boy and a baby girl. If we should visit the Woodworth graveyard today we would see one grave where Selah's daughter Elizabeth and her husband Joshua Lanfear buried their little Joshua, Hannah and Willie who all died the same day of cholera ten years ago". Then follows a description of the funeral procession and the funeral preached by Rev. Sherman Minor and the words spoken by Rev. Ezekiel Canfield. The epitaph on Selah's stone in the Pioneer's dialect reads: "The spirit of the just Shant rest forever in the dust".

Both Selah and his wife Rebecca who died June 3 1838 at the age of 81 are buried in the family burying ground located on a high piece of land just bach of the barn on the Woodworth Place. Capt. Gershon Woodworth a brother of Selah as well as Selah's son Selah are buried in the same cemetery. A bronz tablet has been erected in Selah's honor in the M.E. church in Mayfield.

The will of Selah dated Sept 25 1823 was probated Dec.15 1823 is filed at Fonda N.Y. It mentions his wife Rebecca, and children Rosel, Jacob, John, and Ebenezer. His wife and son Ebenezer were executors and Selah Jr. and Dwelly Spalding were witnesses. Selah's and Rebecca's children were:

2. WILLIAM WOODWORTH son of Selah Woodworth (1) was born April 6 1774 and died in Mayfield N.Y. April 26 1812. His will was written Apr 7 1812 and states that he was "very sick in body". His wife Nancy, sons Joel and James, and three daughters are mentioned. The will was witnessed by Selah and Rebecca Woodworth, Selah's father and mother, and by his wife Nancy.

3. EBENEZER WOODWORTH son of Selah Woodworth (1) was born March 19 1776 and died June 15 1885. He married Electa Robbins who died June 16 1851 age 77. Both are buried in the old Mayfield cemetery. They lived on what was afterward known as the old Abram Close Place in Mayfield and had no children. Ebenezer in his will recorded in Johnstown left most of his estate to charity including the Presbyterian Church of Mayfield. His nephew Ebenezer son of Silas was mentioned.
4. ELIZABETH WOODWORTH daughter of Selah Woodworth (1) was born Jan. 21 1778 and married Joshua Lanfear, born 1773. Three of their children died of cholera in 1816 and are buried by their mother in the Woodworth Cemetery. The Lanfear farm was across the creek on the hill opposite the Woodworth farm. This farm was afterward owned by George Lee and is now known as the Lee Farm. Elizabeth died April 24 1831 at the age of 53. Joshua died 1862 and is buried in the Riceville Cemetery.

5. SARAH WOODWORTH daughter of Selah Woodworth (1) was born in White Creek, Washington Co. July 30 1779 and married David Howland son of Stephen Howland of Galaway, Saratoga Co. and a descendant of Henry, brother of John Howland of the Mayflower. David was born in Dutchess Co N.Y. Oct 12 1773. In the 1800 census he was living in Northampton, now Fulton Co. with a son and daughter both under 10. David was a Quaker preacher and about 1805 founded a Society of Friends in LeRayville, Jefferson Co. N.Y. The compiler has a letter written 1930 by Eli Gardner aged 88 telling about David and his family. He knew Davids sisters and Davids children. David died at Mayfield between Feb. 21 1814 and Mar. 7 1814 the dates of making and filing of his will in which he mentioned the following nine children:

Margaret was born at Cambridge N.Y. Nov. 12 1782. Her father also fought in the Revolution. Silas died April 7 1820 and his will is recorded in Rochester N.Y.

7. ROSWELL WOODWORTH son of Selah Woodworth (1) was born Oct 5 1782 in Salisbury Conn. He married Sarah Lanfear who was born in 1785, died 1821 and is buried in the Woodworth Cemetery in Mayfield. Roswell died Apr 15 1848. He is mentioned in a deed in Rochester 1843. There is no record of his children.

8. JOHN WOODWORTH son of Selah Woodworth (1) was born in Salisbury Sept. 28 1784 and m. Oct. 7 1808 Fanny Bemis daughter of Isaac and Mary (Stevens) Bemis. He lived on what is now known as the Bratt House next to the Moore Farm on the Vails Mills Road south of Mayfield N.Y. Selah was Killed at a July Fourth celebration in Broadalbin near his home 1825 when a cannon exploded. His funeral was the second to be held in the new M.E. church at Mayfield his father's Selah being the first. Selah Jr. was buried with his father in the family cemetery. So far as known Selah left only one child. She was shown to be under 10 years of age in the 1820 census of Mayfield.

John Cozzens Sr. came to Mayfield with his brother-in-law Edward Kennicutt in 1800 and bought the farm now occupied by Vernon Brower north of the creek crossing the road to Jackson Summit. 30. MARY HOWLAND daughter of David Howland and Sarah Woodworth (5) at the age of 16 was a quaker preacher when she met Smith Gardner brother of Joel who married Mary's sister Lois. Mary later married Smith Gardner. Joel and Smith were descended from Richard Gardner the imigrant ancestor as follows: Richard's son Thomas m. Mary Pryor; their son Richard m. Mary Shattuck; their son Richard m. Mary Hustice; their son Benjamin m. Hannah Coffeen; their son Logan m. Hannah Butler; their son Sylvanius had sons Sylvanus and Elijah.
